Open to the public, the U.S. Women's Amateur will offer Charlotte and surrounding communities, seven days of exciting, competitive golf featuring the finest amateurs in the world. Held August 9 through August 15, 2010, this historic community event will provide our city with a rare opportunity to witness outstanding competitive golf close-up at no charge.

## **U.S. WOMEN'S AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIP HISTORY**

The 2010 U.S. Women's Amateur Championship is one of the United States Golf Association's original three championships. It was first conducted in 1895, shortly after the inaugural U.S. Amateur and U.S. Open. The Women's Amateur has since been conducted every year except 1917-18, when it was temporarily suspended because of World War I, and 1942-45, when it was suspended because of World War II.
